WHAT TO EXPECT FROM AN ADJUSTMENT?

First you should know what an adjustment is. A chiropractic adjustment is the use of a specific force in a precise direction that helps normalize joint and spinal function.

The Doctor performs adjustments by hand or with the use of instruments such as special tables or hand held devices. You often feel the bones or muscles move during the adjustment.

Relief of symptoms may begin immediately or may take time and further treatments. Most people feel different after the treatment.

Treatments at Fernley Chiropractic usually involve the use of ancillary modalities for full benefit from the adjustment and quickest results.

WHAT IF I HURT AFTER THE TREATMENT?

Some people feel discomfort after an adjustment or use of ancillary therapies. Mild discomfort is nothing to be alarmed about. Remember, your body may have changed your neurologic patterns, posture, length of muscles, ligaments and tendons to accommodate for the stresses and injuries you have had. Convincing your body that the new motions and positions are an improvement may take some time and persistence. Treatments usually become easier and more comfortable as care continues.

If you have increased pain that lasts for longer than a day, is sharp or pinching, radiates pain away from the injury site, or if something just does not feel right, contact us so the doctor can check you. There is no charge for a check up within a day of treatment.

If the Doctor feels you need to seek a second opinion or see a specialist he will refer you to one of the many doctors and

specialists that work with our office.
